- Once students meet the baseline criteria for auditioning, selection for the program is based solely on the audition results.
- Students must attend each scheduled audition. Students who do not audition will not qualify.
- Each school establishes its own audition procedures. Questions regarding these procedures or programs offered should be directed to the individual school.
- Some programs require students to audition in two areas; therefore, please select a first, second, and third art area choice. Please refer to the description of the individual program to select your art area choices.
