# School Updates for the 2017-18 School Year

#### Dress Code Update

### Shorts, slacks, pants, skorts, skirts and dresses:

Bottoms should be Khaki, blue or <u>black</u>. If falling around hips, students must wear a belt. Skirts, dresses and skorts must be at least fingertip length. Jeans with Shadowbriar Bulldog spirit t-shirts or Shadowbriar club shirts can be worn on Friday. Jeans must be one solid blue color without holes.

#### Earrings and hair:

Children wearing earrings are allowed stud earrings only but nose piercings are not allowed. Hair color must be of natural tones, rainbow colors are not allowed. No distracting hair color.

#### Shoes and socks:

Closed-toed flat shoes with short socks should be worn every day. Tights can be worn but must be a solid color. Shoes must have a non-slip sole (no Crocs). Shoes or boots with heels or wheels are not allowed.

#### Shirts:

Students may purchase Shadowbriar bulldog spirit t-shirts for \$10. Shadowbriar spirit t-shirts may be worn any day of the week. Jackets must be a solid color.

## We are a community focused on learning. Any piece of clothing, shoes, accessories, makeup or hair design that is observed to distract/detract from that focus can be a violation of school dress code and may be addressed by administration.

#### **School Hours**

**8:00 am – 3:20 pm** Students will be allowed to enter the building at 7:30 am. Students need to arrive to school before 8:00 am and students arriving after 8:00 am will be counted tardy. Breakfast will end each morning at 8:10 am. Students will not be released after 2:45 pm in an effort to support student learning and maintain a smooth dismissal. Do not drop your students off before 7:30 am. This is a safety concern as our doors do not open until 7:30 am each morning. Students must be picked up each day by 3:40 pm.







#### **Important Information and Updates**

---Every Shadowbriar student will receive a *Wednesday folder*, which will go home each Wednesday with important information from the teacher to the parents such as student behavior and academics. This is a great resource that supports communication between students, parents and the teacher.

---On the first Wednesday of every month a school-wide communication entitled the *Bulldog News* goes out to every parent in addition to a grade-level newsletter. These two items will be included in the Wednesday folder the first Wednesday of every month and provides parents/guardians with additional information at the school-level and for the specific gradelevel. The first editions of these two communications will go out Wednesday, September 6<sup>th</sup>.

---Parent and Student Handbooks will be sent home the first week of school. This will provide parents/guardians with important information regarding our school and policies.

---Each student in grades 3-5 will receive a Leader In Me agenda that will assist them with organizing their school day and making good choices.

---Each teacher will provide parents with a Year-At-A-Glance document that outlines big academic goals for the campus and the content to be covered in each academic area. The teachers also outline other helpful information for parents/guardians in this document as well.
