The Tame Your Brain elective students were inspired by a book called, "Ordinary Mary's Extraordinary Deed" to spread gratitude and kindness in our school. So, we teamed up with Student Leadership to start a chain of kindness at ROE.

Doesn't it feel good when you are appreciated? We want to make sure everyone at ROE feels loved and appreciated.

Here's how it works: Each class received a bag of colored paper strips. Every time anyone in the school sees someone doing something kind, they can write the person's name and a description of their kind deed on a strip of paper.

The strips of paper get connected to other strips of paper to form a chain in the halls. Each class and office was assigned one color

from the rainbow, and when the classroom chains get long enough to connect, it will make a rainbow chain in the halls.

Our goal is to connect the chains throughout the entire school! We started today, and we will finish on Valentine's Day in February.
