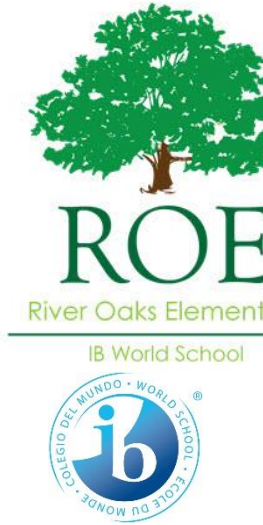

Dear 5th Grade Parents:

Tomorrow, we will celebrate the culmination of your child's elementary experience at ROE. Please join us on the blacktop for the 2016 fifth grade promotion ceremony from 8:00 AM until 9:00 AM.

For your convenience, three locations are available for entry to receive a visitor's badge. You may enter at the Avalon Gate at the west end of the 3rd, 4th and 5th hallway, the front entrance of the school or the carpool lane gate (closest to the pavilion). For drop off and mobility convenience, we recommend you use the carpool lane to drop off guests, before you park. (Please follow all carpool procedures). Coach Bomersbach will be stationed at this gate to assist with your guests. Outside gates will open at 7:15 AM.

If you enter through the front of the building, you will be escorted to the courtyard starting at 7:30 AM. Rossini Café at San Felipe Place has generously donated a coffee bar for parents in the courtyard.

If you intend to bring a sibling to the event, please do not send them to class prior to the ceremony. Take the sibling to the promotion ceremony first, and then check them into school at the front office after the ceremony. Parents will be responsible for ROE siblings during the event.

After the event, your 5th grader will pick up their report card, class gift and enjoy a dessert reception in their classrooms. If you intend to attend another child's party later in the day, you will need to visit the front office and check in through VIPS. We will no longer honor 5th grade promotion badges after 10:00 AM.

Episcopal High School is running a soccer camp August 1st-4th and here are the details:

- Session I - 9am-12pm - boys and girls entering 1st-5th grades
- Session II - 4pm-7pm - girls only entering 6th-9th grades

Directed by EHS head girls 'coach Baron Heinemann, assisted by varsity players, this camp aims to strengthen soccer basics and FUNDamentals in rising 1st-5th grade male and female players. Topics will include: dribbling, passing, trap-ping, shielding, and 2-player combinations. Players will spend most of the time with a ball at their feet, becoming more comfortable with the demands of the individual game. Through varied activities and friendly competition, players will learn the most critical fundamental skills of the game, as well as the most common mistakes.
