FACILITY UPDATE

ROE has received a major face lift on the inside of the building this summer. The interior has a fresh coat of paint and several renovations are in progress. You will notice the following: new paint in the cafeteria and library, lockers painted in old wing, new shelving installed in the library, cafeteria restroom renovation, updated teacher workroom and lounge areas, new flooring in the main office, AC cleaning and repairs, repairs in classrooms as needed, additional data drops and wireless access points added, refurbished shelving installed for lost and found, red doors repainted, walls repaired due to water damage, repairs to playground equipment, drainage system assessments, cleaning and much more.

INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM UPDATE

The International Baccalaureate curriculum as well as our inquiry based and differentiated instructional models continue to be the focus for all students at ROE. All teachers are trained in IB as well as hold Gifted and Talented certifications in order to be prepared to meet the needs of our gifted learners. Providing access to Gifted and Talented Standards to all students in a heterogeneous setting has proved remarkable results for ROE students. Teachers work with students individually to assess their needs, and then develop individualized and small group instruction to stretch students one year above their current performance.

We are also excited about our upcoming IB Program Evaluation. To maintain authorization, all IB Schools undergo an evaluation to verify schools meet the required standards and practices set forth by the IB Organization. Last year, we spent our Wednesday afternoons aligning state and national standards to our IB Planners, and we will continue staff development in August and Wednesdays focused on the required standards and practices set forth by the IBO. I have full confidence we are on track for another successful evaluation.

Lastly, **our schedule will stay the same** (M,T, TH, F 7:45 a.m.-3:15 p.m. and Wed. 7:45 a.m.-12:45 p.m.). We will still have early dismissal on Wednesdays. 

Morning Arrival Procedures



School starts at 7:35 a.m. Tardy bell is at 7:45 a.m.

- Carpool opens at 7:10 a.m.

-Carpool line enters only heading East on San Felipe. -Carpoolers are encouraged to arrive prior to 7:20 a.m. -Parents may park on the area streets to escort children into the front of the building. (*Parents must exit the building by* 7:45 *a.m.*)

-Parents with walkers enter and exit at the front entrance only. All parents should stop by the front office, and pick up a visitor's badge. Visitors should wear a badge at all times.

Afternoon Dismissal Procedures

3:15 p.m. Dismissal- M, T, Th, F 12:45 p.m. Dismissal- W

-ROE Carpool signs MUST be displayed in vehicle windows.

-The carpool line enters only heading East on San Felipe. -Parents may park on the area streets and walk to designated area for student pickup.

-Meet your child at the designated exit location.

Safety Precautions

-AVOID cutting across Bellmeade or enter West on San Felipe into the carpool line.

-AVOID blocking driveways/traffic, using residential driveways or making u-turns.

-AVOID stopping in the street and calling children to your vehicle.

-Front Circle Drive is for Buses Only

-AVOID being towed. Adhere to all City of Houston Parking Signage.

Dear Parents,

Here is a friendly reminder to provide a change of clothes for children at school. These can be kept in a plastic bag in the locker or in the backpack but should include shirt, underwear, pants and socks. Don't forget to change them when the weather changes. We do have accidents at school which can include spills and puddles and your child will feel his or her best if he/she has a change of clothes.

Also, in order to give any medication during school hours, whether it is over the counter or prescription, a medication form must be signed by the doctor. These medication forms are available from the nurse.
