The new North Forest High School will formally open its doors when we return from winter break on **Monday, Jan. 8, 2018.** Students should report that day to our new building, located at 10726 Mesa Drive.

School hours will remain the same — 8:15 a.m. to 3:40 p.m., Monday through Friday, with doors opening at 7:55 a.m. for breakfast. Students arriving on the first day of school should enter through the main entrance and report to the cafeteria. Our regular dress code — khaki pants and black collared shirt — will apply.

The new campus can be accessed via two driveways located off of Mesa Drive. The east driveway is reserved for school buses. The west driveway is reserved for cars and will allow you to access our student drop-off lane in front of the school. This driveway also will allow you to access our student and visitor parking lots located at the front of the school and faculty parking lots located at the rear and west of the building.

As always, all parents and visitors must use the main front entrance to check-in with school staff before gaining entry into the building.

This is truly a momentous occasion for our school community, and I'm sure you're as excited as I am to see the new school. We will be hosting an Open House on Thursday, Jan. 11 at 6 p.m. so that you can meet your student's teachers and come take a look around. We hope to see you there.
