**IB** News: We look forward to a new & exciting year as we make our progress toward becoming an IB World School. Wharton will be submitting our application for authorization on October 1st. In preparation, seventeen teachers and administrators attended IB workshops at Lamar High School last week and two more teachers are taking IB online courses this fall. Parent volunteers have also assisted with other IB projects this summer that will assist students in their units of inquiry and development toward becoming global learners through the IB Learner Profile.

Due to limited parking, the schedule is staggered with 1st -5th grade invited from 4:30-5:30PM and PK-K from 5:30-6:30PM. The evening will provide you the opportunity to find out classroom assignments, meet your teacher(s), and visit classrooms. You will also be able to meet other families and enjoy a frozen treat. Lastly, you will also be able to learn about our PTO, enroll in our CASE After School Program, pick up car rider and walker passes, drop off your child's school supplies, and become an official Wharton volunteer through VIPS!

Middle School Orientation: Middle school students/parents are invited to attend an orientation meeting on Wed., August 21st from 5 - 6:30 PM. Everyone will receive crucial information regarding middle school policies, curriculum, clubs, after-school activities, community service, and more. Middle school shirts/hoodies will be on sale. Please join us!



Dismissal at 3:00PM: There are 5 ways for a student to leave campus at the end of the day: 1) they are taken to the Cafeteria at 3:00 PM to begin our after-school program; 2) parents drive into the circular driveway for curbside pick-up, as long as they have a yellow carpool pass displayed on the dash; 3) they board an HISD bus on Columbus street; 4) they are picked up by an authorized person from school by the PK playground, with a blue walker pass; or, 5) they walk home - middle school only.

Breakfast Offerings: HISD will continue our First Class Breakfast in the classroom free to all students this year. Breakfast will be served from 7:30 - 8:00 AM daily. Our students will have a choice of entrée and side selections and will not be required to take all items of the meal. Students will only be asked to choose a minimum of 2 items (of their choice) among the options available. Please arrive on time so your children may be offered a healthy breakfast!

After School Program: Sign up your children for our fantastic After School Program! We offer many different activities for your child to enjoy throughout the school year. The After School Program begins immediately after dismissal at 3 PM and ends at 6 PM daily. First, students are picked up from their classrooms and walked to the cafeteria for a snack. Students then attend a homework assistance class or an enrichment class according to the weekly schedule. Classes end at 5:30 PM. During the last 30 minutes students are dismissed from the cafeteria for parent pickup. The cost of the program is \$1900 per child for the year. We offer a 9 month payment plan, the first payment is due on August 30th and the last payment is due on Friday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Families with more than one child will be charged \$1200 per additional child per year. CASE provides a sliding tuition scale for a limited number of qualifying families. You may sign up for the After School Program starting on Monday, August 19th - Friday through August 23rd from 10AM - 3PM, with extended hours on Wednesday, August 21st and Friday, August 23rd until 6PM.
