#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YOU TO KNOW:

- REGISTRATION: Registrations are processed as they are received. The date and/or order of registration submission will be recorded on your paperwork.
  - Beginning November 30: Registration forms are available online: http://www.houstonisd.org/domain/36909
    Refer to the deadlines listed on the front cover of the registration packet.
  - By December 16: Registrations received by December 16 will receive a statement via U.S. mail by December 29.
  - **Beginning January 4:** Statements for Registrations received after December 16 will be available for pick up in the AIMS ASP office beginning January 4. Anyone registering on January 4 will be provided services beginning Monday, Jan. 9.
- 2. <u>OUTSTANDING BALANCES:</u> Registration cannot be accepted from anyone who has an outstanding balance from any previous semester. Registrations submitted must include a separate check for their outstanding balance in addition to their first payment. Any accounts with outstanding balances remaining after December 2, 2016 will be assessed a \$25.00 fee which will be rolled over to the Spring 2017 semester. In addition, Any accounts with outstanding balances remaining after April 7 will be assessed a \$25.00 fee which will be rolled over to the Fall 2017 semester Failure to meet your financial obligations may result in suspension of services to you.
- 3. PAYMENT: You may either pay the full amount of your bill at the time of registration or you may pay in 4 installments. This is offered as a convenience to you. Please see the Contract Agreement Safety Plan Form or the Front Cover Page for important details including deadlines.
- 4. <u>SCHOLARSHIPS:</u> Scholarships based on financial need for AIMS ASP are available. You must contact the ASP Office for further information at 713-529-3507 or ciasp2@sbcglobal.net
- 5. Please note the following important details regarding your 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, choices for Enrichment Classes:
  - If the 1<sup>st</sup> choice is filled, we will automatically assigned either the, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup>, choices you selected on your enrichment class forms. If all choices are filled, you will receive a phone call. If we are unsuccessful in contacting you via phone,, you will be sent an email informing you of available classes. You must respond to this email within 2 business days. If you wish to select another class. Other classes may fill up quickly.
  - If you enrolled in an enrichment class and it is canceled due to lack of enrollment, a full refund for that class will be issued if your account has a "credit" balance and if you request a refund in writing. Otherwise, the credit will be rolled over to the Fall 2017 Semester. In the event of teacher illness, a substitute will be provided OR students will be contacted as early as possible to inform them of a class cancellation.

- 1. <u>REGISTRATION FOR EXTENDED DAY:</u> Registration in the Extended Day Program (Jan. 4-May 25) is for the Spring Semester. Tuition and fees are not prorated after the Add/Drop deadline of January 20. Only 2 changes are permitted during the Add/Drop. I understand that my registration is ONLY valid if I have paid out all prior balances owed to the school. Furthermore, I understand the following:
  - If I submit my registration after December 22, I will be assessed a Late Registration Fee of \$25.00.
  - If I submit my registration on January 4 my registration may be processed for services to begin by Monday, January 9.
  - I must make other arrangements for After School until my child's registration has been processed.
  - In addition, NO refunds will be assessed in the event of HISD canceling after-school activities for inclement weather or any other extenuating circumstances.
  - The entire cost of the class is to be paid in full by the due dates, as listed on the cover page of this packet.
- 2. REGISTRATION FOR ENRICHMENT CLASSES: Enrichment Classes are scheduled to begin the week of January 9. Add/Drop Deadline is January 20. After the Add/Drop Deadline, there are no prorations or refunds should you drop a class. The entire cost of the class is to be paid in full by the due dates, as listed on the cover page of this packet.
- 3. NOTIFICATION TO AIMS IF MY CHILD'S AFTER SCHOOL PLAN CHANGES: It is my responsibility to inform in writing (written note or email to: <a href="mailto:molivas@houstonisd.org">molivas@houstonisd.org</a> AND <a href="mailto:aimsaspcoordinator@sbcglobal.net">aimsaspcoordinator@sbcglobal.net</a>) that my child will not attend the after school program on any day you plan to pick up at the school's dismissal. Otherwise, the school expects your child to attend the after school program, according to your Ext Day Option (Full Time, Half Time, Enrichment). Again, there are no prorations if your child does report to Ext Day on any given day.
- 4. NOTIFICATION TO AIMS FOR MY CHILD TO ATTEND AFTER SCHOOL IF MY CHILD IS ENROLLED IN OCCASIONAL EXTENDED DAY: If I have enrolled my child in Occasional Extended Day, I will notify in writing (written note or email to: <a href="mailto:molivas@houstonisd.org">molivas@houstonisd.org</a> AND <a href="mailto:aimsaspcoordinator@sbcglobal.net">aimsaspcoordinator@sbcglobal.net</a>) each time my child is to attend the after school program.
- 5. <u>SIGN OUT:</u> I will sign out my child from an After School Staff Member each day. If my child is enrolled ONLY in Enrichment Classes, I will sign out my child from an After School Staff Member located in the front office at the time the Enrichment Class ends. **SHOWING PHOTO ID IS MANDATORY UPON REQUEST.**
- 6. LATE PICK UP:
  - If my child is enrolled in **Full Time Extended Day** and is picked up after 6:00 PM I understand I will be assessed a late pickup fee of **\$2.00**/ **per minute**.
  - If my child is enrolled ONLY IN AN ENRICHMENT CLASS AND I am late picking up my child by the end of class time, I understand I may be assessed a late pick up fee of \$2.00/minute. If I am late more than 6 minutes, I have the option of purchasing Occ Extended Day of 5-Units which will provide supervision until 6:00 PM. 1 Unit from this card will be used for the late pick up of the day I purchase this option and I understand that I will have 4 Units remaining. After 6:00 PM, I will be assessed a fee of \$2.00/minute.
  - After the 5th late pick-up I may be asked to make other arrangements for After School Services.
  - The official time for our after school program will be gauged by the clock located in the school office.
  - <u>Please Note: If late pick-up fees are not paid within 24 hours, the fee is automatically doubled</u> (Check or money order only)
- 7. <u>EXT DAY & ENRICHMENT TIMES:</u> I understand that the times of the Enrichment Classes are: 3:30 4:30 or 4:35-5:35 OR 3:30-4:00; 4:05-4:35; 4:40-5:10; 5:15-5:45 and the hours of Extended Day are: Full Time Extended Day 3:00-6:00 p.m.; Half Time Extended Day 3:00-5:00.
- 8. Should my child be enrolled ONLY in an ENRICHMENT CLASS AFTER 3:30: I must enroll my child in either a 3:30 Enrichment Class, Bridge to Enrichment for supervision until the start time of class, or Occasional Extended Day.
- 9. OCCASIONAL EXTENDED DAYS:
  - If I no longer have any Occasional Extended Day Units, I understand another 5-Unit Card will be AUTOMATICALLY assessed to my account.
  - I understand that any Occasional Extended Day Unit purchases billed after April 7 MUST BE PAID WITHININ
     24 HOURS OR THERE WILL BE NO SERVICES PROVIDED.

### ARABIC IMMERSION MAGNET SCHOOL (AIMS) DESCRIPTION OF ENRICHMENT CLASSES

**SPRING 2017** 

#### **MONDAY**

<u>Ballet/Tap</u> - Combo Dance Classes in ballet. Classes will emphasize balance, rhythm, flexibility, and musicality for children ages 4 – 7 yrs. old. These weekly sessions will aid a child in exploring movement, gaining self-confidence, and learning how to follow directions in an environment where children are having fun while learning. Dance Class Attire: (Girls) Black Leotard, Pink Tights, Pink Ballet Shoes, and Black Tap Shoes. No skirts or tutus, please. (Boys) T-Shirt, Shorts, Black Ballet Shoes, and Black Tap Shoes. Please send all items marked with child's name in a separate bag so we may assist them to get dressed.

<u>Camp Einstein: Engineering, Science and CSI Forensics</u> - In this class, explore topics in Engineering, Science, and CSI Investigation. Design propeller cars and roller coasters. Explore volcanoes and build a rocket to launch in to the sky. Become a CSI investigator and solve a mystery using blood and DNA analysis. This is the perfect class for the curious minded student who loves to build, create, and see how things work!

<u>Soccer</u> - This class teaches the students the game of soccer and gives them an understanding of the rules. It helps them develop fundamental skills needed in the game as well as adding a good form of exercise to their day. Technique is emphasized more as the student learns to master more difficult maneuvers. The challenge and excitement of the games keeps learning fun! Soccer will help the students better their foot skills, balance, coordination, agility, and most importantly, their teamwork skills. Main topics in Soccer Clinics (dribbling, passing, foot skills, turning, shooting) confidence on the ball.

#### **TUESDAY**

<u>Getting Ready Art</u> - An introduction to representational drawing geared to the attention span and motor coordination of 4+ year old students. Students learn to recognize the elements of shape. This program has a progressive curriculum. It is structured to give enough to students to succeed and enough freedom to express. The curriculums for the first semester will be handed out on a first class level. All art work will be placed into their individual portfolios along with a progress report and be handed back at the last class.

<u>Karate/Martial Arts</u> - Operation Fit is on mission to improve and enhance children's lives through exercising and practicing sports. Karate/martial arts program help to build coordination, balance, discipline, mental concentration, courtesy, and respect. Our class also provides an outstanding alternative for those children who may not do as well in team sports, giving them the chance to excel in a specialized activity while increasing their physical abilities and concentration skills. As a result, children can achieve: healthy bodies, healthy minds, improve level of fitness, better academic achievement, reduce childhood obesity rates, and increase self-esteem. We should encourage our children to strive for perfection and reach their full potential. We look forward to meeting your children and building a healthy lifestyle together!!

<u>Mad Science</u> - Put on your goggles and dust off those lab coats, it is time for SCIENCE! Our classes are hands-on, interactive and fun. Children will explore a different science topic every week and receive a take home in each class for them to continue to learn at home. Mad Science will teach children that science is all around them and that curiosity is never a bad thing!

#### **WEDNESDAY**

<u>ArtSmart</u> - ArtSmart is an early learning program that introduces young children to the wonderful world of art. While building fine motor skills students explore color, texture, shapes, and different types of art materials and learn to express their ideas through art.

<u>Chess</u> - Children of all ages and abilities will be taught the game of chess from experienced tournament players. Lessons are tailored to the abilities of the class. Beginners will be taught the basics (how the pieces move, the rules, etc.) while more experienced players will be given problems to solve, lessons in tactics, checkmates, openings, etc. Children will be split into groups by ability if more than 20 children enroll.

<u>Musical Theater</u> – This class will incorporate acting, dancing and singing, culminating with a final performance at the end of the semester. HITS has been a theatre in the Heights for over 25 years and has been helping students achieve life skills through stage skills, addressing the need for a quality performing arts education while providing a nurturing and affirming environment for young people to learn and grow as performers and individuals. HITS Theatre is a nonprofit organization with two major goals for children in the arts: education and performance. However, a HITS education involves much more than learning to sing, dance and act. It helps transform students into disciplined team players, creative thinkers, and confident communicators. While many of our alumni have gone on to careers in the performing arts, many more have used the life skills and confidence they developed at HITS to become successful in other careers, including medicine, law and business.

<u>Private Piano</u> – From early childhood music to music literacy, children will begin to play the songs they've been hearing, singing, and dancing to throughout the years of early-childhood as they are introduced to the keyboard. In this class, they will become comfortable with D, C and G major 5 finger positions as well as d, c and e minor. They will be introduced to chords to accompany their songs. Finally, they will master pieces of music they enjoy most by selecting genres of their choice. NOTE: It is mandatory the child has a keyboard or piano in their home so they may practice their music on a daily basis for a minimum of 30 minutes.

#### **THURSDAY**

<u>Outdoor Sports -</u> In this class a variety of outdoor sports such as Fun Flag Football, Softball/Baseball, Soccer and Basketball will be taught.

<u>Yoga</u> - Yoga for children is full of fun lessons integrating a mix of yoga poses (Asanas), games and improvisation where the goals are: to have a positive effect on the academic achievement, general health, personal attributes, and relationships of students; that each class is accompanied by other elements such as music and games; to learn techniques for self-health, relaxation, and inner fulfillment. Yoga at an early age encourages self-esteem and body awareness to enhance flexibility, strength and coordination. In addition, their concentration and sense of calmness and breath awareness improves to use improvisation, animal adaptations, story telling and visualizations for a more fun and dynamic lesson to think of our self as a facilitator rather than a teacher to have fun, feel good and remember to enjoy the moment.

#### Shazam! I'm A Super Pet!!!

Do you want to be like your favorite animal cartoon character, like Ming-Ming Duckling, Ace the Bat-Hound, or Linny the Guinea Pig? Come draw, paint and design your own Super Pet with us. Learn teamwork, problem solving, 2 and 3D art making, while strengthening your friendships. This class will prepare your child to navigate through the stages of becoming a Super Pet.

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#### **FRIDAY**

#### An Engineering World (STEM)

This spring will be packed with exciting STEM adventures for our youngest AIMS engineers! Juniors will start with exploring the world of **aerospace engineering** - students learn about aerodynamics by testing out their plane, helicopter, and rocket designs! Students will then move onto the fascinating world of **mechanical engineering**, where every class they will build their own toy that can pop, buzz, and whirl! We will finish the semester with **electrical engineering** - where the will use logic based programming and a library of littleBits® modules such as Arduino to design gadgets, tools, and machines as a team!

#### Make Me Cultural - Countries we will focus on: Egypt, France, Syria!

We help kids to understand their heritages, build positive friendships and jumpstart for global opportunities. Join us on our journey to learn 1/3 of the world before entering college! Language is easily forgotten; Culture lasts a lifetime. Learning about our diverse world has never been more FUN! Our curriculum includes S.T.E.A.M and Language activities. Kids build 2D & 3D puzzles of countries, and known landmarks, eat and make tasty snacks, design and make traditional, modern homes and clothing, musical instruments, perform dances, play known ethnic field and board games. Kids also learn manners while meeting, eating and speaking native languages.

<u>Hip Hop</u> - Classes will emphasize an introduction to hip-hop movement, street/pop current style dancing, and athletic dance "tricks/breakdancing". - 1. <u>REGISTRATION FOR EXTENDED DAY:</u> Registration in the Extended Day Program (Jan. 4-May 25) is for the Spring Semester. Tuition and fees are not prorated after the Add/Drop deadline of January 20. Only 2 changes are permitted during the Add/Drop.
