ATTENDANCE MATTERS!:



Attendance matters for success in school and in life, and absences can easily add up to academic trouble. At Houston ISD, missing more than 10 percent of school a year can lead to a student *not receiving a grade or being retained*, but more importantly, it represents lost time in the classroom and a lost opportunity to learn.

- A child is considered chronically absent if they miss two or more days a month. That includes unexcused and excused absences.
- Attendance matters as early as kindergarten. Studies show that children who miss too many days in kindergarten and first grade have trouble mastering reading.
- By grade 6, chronic absence is a proven warning sign that a student is at risk of dropping out.

PRE-K & KINDER PRE-REGISTRATION FOR 2015-2016:



Pre-registration for children who will be attending Pre-K and Kindergarten in the 2015-2016 school year will take place on April 27 - May 1, 2015 from 8:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Pre-K and Kinder enrollment packets will be available in the front office from April 6-24, 2015. Before receiving a registration packet, you *MUST* submit <u>ALL</u> required documentation. Please note that you will receive notice in the mail to bring

new proof of residence and income around mid-July. The law states that proof of income and residence can be no older than 60 days from start of school. Packet forms **MUST** be filled out completely when they are brought in on registration days. It is the parents' responsibility to return the packet during the registration period. All applications will be reviewed and are subject to approval. Bilingual Pre-K students will be called to take a test, please make sure that we have good working phone numbers in order to contact you. Requirements are as follows:

- Pre-K must be 4 years old before or on September 1
- Kinder must be 5 years old before or on September 1
- Proof of income for students enrolling in Pre-K (New proof will be requested in mid-July)
- Current shot record shots must be up to date NO EXCEPTIONS
- Social Security card (if available)
- Parent or Guardian *MUST* be present to enroll
- Birth certificate (original not copy)

- Students who attended school this past year, **MUST** bring last report card
- Driver's license or official picture I.D.
- ▶ Proof of address (light, water, gas bill, or rent receipt with lease contract no older than 1 month old). The utility bill or lease contract must have the parent or guardian's name on it. (New proof will be requested in mid-July)

PLEASE NOTE:

The Texas Education Code requires Proof of Income for children

enrolling in Pre-Kindergarten. Please see the following for a list of acceptable documentation:

- Current paycheck stub, current pay envelopes, letter from employer stating gross wages paid & how often they are paid, Worker's Compensation or Disability payment stub.
- Acceptable documentation for self-employment income include: business or farming documents, such as ledger books and/or self-issued paychecks tub, last year's tax return.
- Acceptable documentation for cash income include: a letter from the employer stating wages paid & frequency

FREE TAX PREPARATION:



There is FREE tax preparation, sponsored by Neighborhood Tax Centers/United Way, available at several neighborhood locations from January through April 2015. They will provide for *FREE*: tax preparation, e-filing for fast refund, direct deposit, and ITIN application. No appointment is necessary – walk-ins only. Families and individual earning up to \$58,000

are eligible. The nearest location to Lyons ES is at LINC Houston, 161 West Road, 77037. Open in March Monday-Friday from 11:00-7:00 & Saturdays 9:00-1:00. In April Monday-Friday 10:00-7:00 & Saturdays 9:00-4:00. For more locations or information please call the Texas/United Way Helpline at 211.
