DIRECTIONS:

Draw a picture or illustration of your character in the middle of a poster board. Then find and write the following neatly and attractively on the poster:

Title and author of your chosen nonfiction book.

- 1. Two quotations that show the character's personality (show page #s)
- 2. Two quotations that show the character's wants/desires/ambitions (show page #s)
- 3. Two quotations that show relationships with other characters (show page #s)
- 4. Two quotations that show the character's appearance (show page #s)

EXAMPLE:

<u>RELATIONSHIP WITH PHOEBE</u>: "You should see her. You never saw a little kid so pretty and smart in your whole life. She's really smart. I mean, she's had all A's ever since she started school" (Larson 67).
