LIBRARY NEWS

HELMET & CHAINS

If your child rides a bicycle to school, it is important to play it safe! Children are required to wear a helmet while riding a bicycle. Join the "helmet patrol" and see that all children are following bicycle safety rules.

We have a bike rack for parking. <u>All bikes and scooters should</u> <u>be chained and locked to prevent theft.</u> Be sure that your child has a bike lock he/she can operate.

CARPOOL COURTESY

Cars that line up for dismissal should line up on Westerloch up to the stop sign at Park Bayou. The line should then continue along Park Bayou going towards West Briar Middle School. <u>Please be</u> <u>respectful towards the cars patiently waiting in line and do</u> <u>not "cut" in the line at the stop sign at Westerloch and Park</u> <u>Bayou or in the carpool lane.</u>

Here are some tips to help keep the carpool lane moving.

- Help your child memorize his/her carpool number.
- Have the seats on the carpool side (passenger side) of your car free of clutter or obstructions so children can easily enter their cars.
- Have your carpool number displayed from your rear view mirror. If some other item is also hanging from the mirror, place the carpool number in front.
- Keep your number visible right up to the time you pick up your child. Sometimes a number must be called several times.
- Do not get out of your car in the carpool lane.
