#### **NEW CELL PHONE POLICY**

On January 23, 2014, the Bush Excellence Committee (BEC/SDMC) approved our new cell phone policy.

Students are allowed to have a cell phone in their backpack to use **only** to communicate with parents after school starting at 2:50 p.m. Cell phones are **not** allowed to be on or used during the school day. The first time a cell phone is visible (seen or heard) during the school day, it will be confiscated and turned in to the office. The teacher will notify the parent to pick up the phone from the office. At the time of pick up, the parent will sign an acknowledgement that he/she is aware of a \$15.00 administrative fee for any subsequent times the phone is confiscated thereafter. If the phone is not picked up within 30 days, the office will no longer be responsible for the phone. Multiple confiscations will result in a discipline referral. This cell phone policy became effective on February 6.

### **EARLY DISMISSAL**

The next Early Dismissal Day is Wednesday, February 19. The school day will be from 7:35 a.m. – 12:20 p.m. There will be an altered ancillary schedule and lunch times will run one hour and ten minutes earlier on these days only. Students must be picked up at 12:20 p.m.
