CONFERENCES

Parent/teacher conferences are a valuable tool to be used in helping children to be happy and successful at school. Be sure to take advantage of this tool! Because it is so important, please follow these guidelines to ensure that you have the best possible conference with your child's teacher.

To arrange for a conference:

1. Make an appointment: Call the office at 281-368-2150, write a note to the teacher, leave a message on the teacher's voicemail, or e-mail the teacher to arrange an appointment time. 2. Plan to come to school: Teachers can share work samples, clarify assignments, etc. when personal rather than telephone conferences are held.

3. Be "tuned in" to your child so you know when to request a conference. Watch test papers, progress reports, etc. that signal trouble areas.

4. Please do not drop in for just a minute at the beginning or end of the day. These are especially crucial times when the class needs and deserves the teacher's full attention.

5. Please do not ask to have teachers called out of class for a conference. Instructional time belongs to all the students.

ATTENDANCE

The attendance goal for all HISD schools is 98%. Last year's attendance rate was 97.5% which was a decrease by just 0.3% from the previous year; yet it contributed to a reduction in Bush Elementary's operating budget by \$69,944. Please ensure your child is at school on time every day so your child receives the maximum learning opportunities in the classroom.

Please do not schedule extra trips on school days.

Help us achieve our 98% attendance goal and all students will benefit by learning more and having a better-funded school.

LONG DISTANCE PHONE NUMBERS

It is imperative that all information on each child's enrollment card be complete and kept current. We have a few parents who still have long distance phone numbers listed. **Please make sure we have <u>local</u> phone numbers on file because we are unable to make long distance calls from school.**

FIRE DRILL

The City of Houston requires that schools conduct a monthly fire drill. All people in the building are required to leave the building whenever the fire alarm sounds. Parents and volunteers must exit the building as soon as they hear the alarm and follow the others in the hall to a proper evacuation site. Thank you for helping make Bush a safe and secure campus.

CELL PHONE MISUSE!

Cell phones are **<u>not</u>** allowed to be on or used during the school day. Cell phones that are visible (seen or heard) during the school day will be confiscated and turned in to the office. The parents may come to the office to retrieve the phone. Repeated confiscation of the cell phone will cause the cell phone to be placed in the "June Box." Then, the parent may pick up the cell phone on the last day of school at the earliest.

BOBCAT WEAR

Students may wear solid navy, red or white polo-type shirts (with or without the official Bush logo) or turtlenecks in the same three solid colors. **Official** Bush t-shirts may be worn on any school day. White Oxford cloth shirts with long or short sleeves are also acceptable. Shorts, pants, dresses, skirts, or skorts must be solid khaki or navy blue. Shorts, dresses, skirts and skorts must be below fingertips. The guidelines will continue to include <u>**PLAIN**</u> blue jeans. Jeans may **not** have embroidery, colored stitching, decals, logos, glitter, or any other type of decoration. Girls may wear "Bush plaid" items purchased from Parker School Uniforms, located at 12524 Memorial Drive.
