## **Scroggins Dress Code**

Uniforms are to be worn every day of the week unless otherwise notified.

Students should come to school prepared to concentrate on their studies. Distractions should be kept to a minimum.

Students will wear uniforms. The boys will wear FOREST GREEN shirts with a collar and sleeves; navy blue or khaki pants or shorts; navy or black belts; close-toed shoes; navy or white socks. The girls will wear FOREST GREEN shirts or blouses with a collar and sleeves; navy blue or khaki pants, skirts, jumpers, or skorts; navy or white belts; close-toed shoes; navy or white socks.

There will be no denim allowed for boys or girls unless otherwise notified.

## **General Dress Code Guidelines**

- 1. Dresses, shorts, jumpers, and skorts are to be no more than 5 inches above the knee.
- 2. Shirts should be buttoned and inside pants, skirts, skorts, and shorts at all times.
- 3. Bicycle shorts/spandex are not permitted.
- 4. T-shirts with inappropriate pictures, liquor advertisements, sexually suggestive messages, or drug-related messages are not allowed.
- 5. Blouses with straps less than 2 ½ inches in width should not be worn during regular school hours for students in grades 3-5. Spaghetti straps are not allowed.
- 6. Tank tops and halter tops are not permitted.
- 7. Dress clothes should be worn while participating in special programs or special field trips. Occasionally, formal wear may be acceptable for special programs.
- 8. Shirts, sweaters, jackets, or coats are not to be worn tied around the waist.
- 9. Sheer stockings are not acceptable for students in grades Pre-K-5.
- 10. Socks or colored tights are to be worn at all times with shoes.
- 11. Hats, caps, or bandanas of any type are not to be worn.
- 12. Shoes with laces must be worn completely laced with laces tied. Shoes with buckles/velcro must be worn buckled/strapped. Thongs/sandals/flip flops with open heels or toes should not be worn to school. High heels should not be worn to school.
- 13. Hair should be neatly groomed, away from the eyes, and styled in a manner that is not an educational distraction. Colored hair and spiked hair styles such as mohawks and symbols/drawings shaved into the scalp are not allowed since they are a distraction to the student and those around him or her. Hair rollers and combs are not allowed.
- 14. Make-up such as mascara, eye liner, lipstick, rouge, and eye shadow is not permitted during school hours. Any student arriving on campus with make-up will be sent to the nurse's office and required to remove it. Long nails and acrylic/fake nails are not allowed. No visible fake or real tattoos will be allowed. Any student doing so will be sent to the nurse's office to wash it off. Any real tattoos must be covered.
- 15. Students are discouraged from wearing jewelry because jewelry items are easily lost and many times difficult to replace. Boys will not be allowed to wear earrings.

## **Backpacks**

For safety reasons, all students will be required to use only clear (see-through) or mesh backpacks. All other backpacks will not be allowed.

Roller backpacks will not be permitted due to possible accidents.
