- Live in the greater Houston area.

To Enter:

- Students must complete the entire application including teacher and parent information and signatures.
- Students must write an essay (500 words or less) on the assigned topic.
- Essays should be typed on plain white paper, double-spaced.
- The Houston Money Week Essay Contest Application should be attached to the essay pages.
- The essay must be the work of the student submitting the essay.
