# Clearing Browser Cache

## Quick Reference Guide

Target Audience	Purpose
All HISD Employees and Students	To clear the web browser's cache, which can include history, passwords and more.
Clearing the Browser Data	
<p><b>Chrome: Clear Browsing Data</b></p> <p>Deleting the cookies in Google Chrome is done through the <i>Clear browsing data</i> section, which is accessible through <i>Settings</i>. After you choose what you want to delete, like <b>Cookies and other site data</b>, confirm it with a click or tap of the <b>CLEAR BROWSING DATA</b> button.</p> <p>If you're using a keyboard, you can quickly open this part of Chrome's settings with the <b>Ctrl+Shift+Del</b> keyboard shortcut.</p> <p>The same area can be opened without a keyboard by clicking or tapping on the menu at the top right of Chrome (it's the button that has three stacked dots). Choose <b>More tools &gt; Clear browsing data...</b> to open the <i>Clear browsing data</i> section and pick what you want to delete.</p> <p>See <a href="#">How to Delete Cookies in Chrome</a> [<i>support.google.com</i>] for additional information like how to delete cookies from specific websites, how to allow or deny websites from leaving cookies, and more.</p> <p>To clear the cookies from Chrome's mobile browser, tap the menu button on the top right of the screen (the one with three stacked dots), and choose <b>Settings</b>. Under the <b>Privacy</b> submenu, tap <b>Clear Browsing Data</b>. On that new screen, tap each area you want to erase, like <b>Cookies</b>, <b>Site Data</b> or <b>Saved Passwords</b>, etc.</p>	<p><b>Internet Explorer: Delete Browsing History</b></p> <p>The <i>Delete Browsing History</i> section of Internet Explorer is where you delete the cookies. Click or tap the things you want to delete and then use the <b>Delete</b> button to clear them. The option for cookies is called <b>Cookies and website data</b> - if you want to delete all the saved passwords, place a check in the <b>Passwords</b> box.</p> <p>The fastest way to get to this screen in Internet Explorer is to use the <b>Ctrl+Shift+Del</b> keyboard shortcut. The other way is manually, through the settings button (the gear icon at the top right of Internet Explorer), then the <b>Internet options</b> menu item. In the <i>General</i> tab, under the <i>Browsing history</i> section, click the <b>Delete...</b> button.</p> <p>See <a href="#">How to Delete Cookies in Internet Explorer</a> for more help, like how to delete cookies in older versions of Internet Explorer.</p>
<p><b>Safari: Cookies and Other Website Data</b></p> <p>Deleting the cookies in Apple's Safari web browser is done through the <i>Privacy</i> section of <i>Preferences</i>, under the <i>Cookies and other website data</i> section. Click or tap <b>Remove All Website Data...</b> to delete all the cookies or choose <b>Details...</b> to delete website-specific cookies.</p> <p>Whether you're on macOS or Windows, you can get to this section of the browser's settings through the <i>Action</i> menu (the gear icon at the upper-right corner of Safari).</p> <p>Select the <b>Preferences...</b> option and then the <b>Privacy</b> tab. The buttons I mentioned above are under the section called <i>Cookies and other website data</i>:</p> <p>If you use the <b>Remove All Website Data...</b> button, choose the <b>Remove Now</b> button to delete all of Safari's cookies. If you want to delete cookies from specific websites, pick the <b>Details...</b> button and then select the cookies you want to remove - click or tap <b>Remove</b> to delete them.</p>	<p><b>Firefox: Clear All History</b></p> <p>Delete cookies in Mozilla's Firefox browser through the <i>Clear All History</i> window of its <i>Options</i> section. Choose the <b>Cookies</b> option and then the <b>Clear Now</b> button to erase the cookies in Firefox.</p> <p>The easiest way to get to this window in Firefox is with the <b>Ctrl+Shift+Del</b> keyboard shortcut. Another way is through the three-lined menu at the top right of the browser - choose <b>Options &gt; Privacy &gt; clear your recent history</b> to open the <i>Clear All History</i> section.</p> <p>See <a href="#">How to Delete Cookies in Firefox</a> [<i>support.mozilla.org</i>] if you need more help or you want to know how to delete cookies from specific websites only.</p>
