

Welcome to Lanier Middle School!

Lanier Middle School is pleased to offer incoming 6th grade Vanguard students, plus our zoned students attempting to qualify for Vanguard, the opportunity to become familiar with the campus and some of its programs this summer. An intensive Math course and a Language Arts workshop are being offered to our newest Pups.

Summer Math Program

A summer math program is being offered at Lanier Middle School for incoming 6th grade Vanguard students. This program is designed to assist students with mastery of 5th grade TEKS (Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills), as well as cover many 6th grade objectives since the 6th grade Vanguard program is based on 7th grade TEKS. Items to be covered include:

- Organizational skills
- Tour of the building with a question and answer session
- Ordering/comparing fractions and decimals
- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of whole numbers and decimals
- Addition, subtraction and multiplication of fractions
- Addition and subtraction of mixed numbers
- Integer concepts
- Basic order of operations
- Intro. to logic, expressions, and equations

Summer Language Arts Workshop

A summer reading workshop is being offered at Lanier Middle School for incoming 6th grade Vanguard students. This workshop is based on the curriculum offered by Columbia University's Teachers College in New York. This week long class is being offered in order to facilitate the move from elementary school to middle school, to introduce the students to Lanier's language arts program, as well as introducing the students to Lanier's International Baccalaureate Programme and its Approaches to Learning. Items to be covered include:

- Organizational skills (including how to use a locker)
- Touring the building with a question and answering session
- Using schematic thinking
- Questioning around a story
- Growing a theory
- Vocabulary building
- Writing around reading

This class will include a walking field trip to the Barnes and Noble at West Gray in order for each child to self initiate his/her summer reading with a book of his/her choice.

Each session consists of 4 half-days and will start on a Tuesday and end on Friday. (Note: all sessions are the same.)

Cost: \$175.00 per session OR \$275.00 for both Math & Language Arts sessions.

Financial Aid is available for students currently qualified for the free/reduced lunch program at their elementary school.

Free Lunch - \$75.00 per session or \$125.00 for both sessions.

Reduced Lunch - \$100.00 per session or \$175.00 for both sessions.
