Thirteen years ago a spur-of-the-moment comment by Mr. Threet at the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Graduation led to what has become an annual West U Elementary School tradition.

The children who finished 5<sup>th</sup> grade in 2002 were kindergarteners during Mr. Threet's first year at West U in 1996. They were the first group of students going back to 1981 who had the same principal all the way through elementary school. At their 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Graduation Mr. Threet told them if he was still here when they graduated from high school, he would host a reunion. The first High School Seniors Reunion was held in May of 2009. Each year since then, Mr. Threet and some of the teachers welcome our former students back to West U just prior to their high school graduation.
