Region IV is considered to be one of the most competitive in the state and includes schools from Aldine, Spring Branch, Woodlands, Klein and HISD. All of our Wolf region swimmers finished in the top 16 in multiple events on Friday, and returned to swim on Saturday for a chance to advance to the 6A State swim meet. Although several Westside swimmers came up short by just .03, .10 and .08 of a second, we are proud to announce we have two State qualifiers; junior Annika Ruehlicke in the 500yd Freestyle and freshman Emma Clark in the 100yd backstroke.




