



The plans features a major renovation to the school's historic 1928 building, as well as two new additions on the north side that will includes modern spaces for science, the culinary arts magnet program, and performing arts, including new practice rooms, instrument storage and a learning center for dance. Early renderings show larger classrooms, extended learning areas for small group instruction, and a school infused with natural light and vibrant colors.

The new three-story building has been designed with a modern collegiate feel, incorporating the school colors of gold, charcoal, and pearl white. The building design features a large open courtyard that will function as a flexible outdoor learning and gathering space, and also serve as an extension of the dining area. A large grand stair is also featured in the plans and would serve as a flexible informal sitting and gathering space for students, but can also be used by class-sized groups for lectures or presentations.

The updated campus will feature a new JROTC building, classroom renovations, technology upgrades, and a face-lift for the front of the campus. Design plans also include improvements to athletics fields and a tennis court, and a new secure welcome center that will become a focal point at the front of the campus.

Construction expected to start in early October, 2016

This construction project combines the remaining scope from the 2007 Bond Program with additional campus needs identified as part of the 2012 Bond program. The design features a new main entry and central office area, as well as an addition to the building housing the band, girl's athletics, the gym expansion, weight room and the new science lab wing. Plans also call for the creation of additional larger science labs, flex-use extended learning classrooms, and a new ROTC shooting range and classroom, as well as a new fire sprinkler system throughout the building, door replacement, and restroom renovations.
