HOW DO WE ENROLL?

Select your Earth Month Champion, visit **HoustonISD.org/EarthMonth**, and submit the Earth Month Pledge. By taking the pledge, you agree to select and complete at least three activities.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

A menu of activities are grouped into the categories of **Campus** and **Community**. A brief description of each can be found on **HoustonISD.org/EarthMonth**. The campus with the most participation points wins Earth Month 2017!

IS THERE AN INCENTIVE?

The winning campus receives a **Sustainable Schoolyard outdoor classroom** sponsored by Volunteer Houston; the build-out will be completed by early May 2017.

HOW DO WE WIN?

Points of Light and Volunteer Houston

will sponsor the outdoor learning classroom build out, along with a one-year volunteer agreement with **Urban Harvest** and **AARP**, to the school that accumulates the most points. In case of a tie, attendance at an Earth Day

Celebration will determine the winner.
