Direct Services: Offers counseling and safety planning for victims of domestic violence and child abuse. • Counsels persons about domestic violence, grief, life transitions, crime and violence, post-traumatic stress, sexual abuse, and behavioral issues. • Helps victims get protective orders, register for Texas Victim Information and Notification Everyday (VINE) notifications, take part in supervised visits, and file for compensation for crime victims.
