**Direct Services:** Offers **FREE** Parenting and Paternity Awareness curriculum training for educators and youth service providers in schools and community organizations. Parenting and Paternity Awareness program Parenting and Paternity Awareness (P.A.P.A.) is an evidence-based, educational curriculum designed for young adults. It teaches them the benefits of waiting to become a parent until after they have completed their education, started a career, and are in a stable, committed relationship. The P.A.P.A. program is away school districts can comply with state law requiring high-school health to include a parenting and paternity awareness curriculum. The Office of the Attorney General provides this free curriculum and training to teachers, school counselors, school nurses, teen parent program staff, and parent educators in community-based programs. These professionals are then equipped to educate the young adults with whom they work.
