RMS Morning Routine

- Once students enter the campus, they MUST remain on campus.
- Students will enter the campus through the courtyard. 6th grade students will enter through the doors near the auditorium (patio), 7th & 8th grade will enter through the cafeteria from the outside near the courtyard.
- The gates will **open at 7:45 am** and **close at 8:40 am.** Students must enter through the front door near the main office after 8:40 am to receive a tardy pass.
- The 1st bell will ring at 8:25 am Students will be picked up by their Advocacy teacher.
- Students WILL ONLY be dismissed with a teacher

6th Grade

- 6th grade students will meet in the auditorium. Enter using the far-left doors of the courtyard. Doors will open at **7:45** am each morning
- 7th grade students will be released to their Advocacy teachers by **8:25 am**.
- 6th grade students will be seated by their Advocacy teacher.
- 6th grade students will collect their breakfast from the cart/table and proceed to class with the teacher.
- Students will move with a sense of urgency while transitioning to class.
- 6th grade teachers and students will **ONLY USE STAIRWELL 2** near Rm. 107 on the first floor. *See school map*

7th Grade

- 7th grade students will meet in the café'. Doors will open at **7:45** am each morning.
- 7th grade students will be released to their Advocacy teachers by **8:25 am**.
- 7th grade students and teachers will **ONLY USE STAIRWELL 3** near the library. *See school map*
- All 7th grade students will eat breakfast in the café as they arrive.
- 7th grade students are not permitted to take food outside the café.
- Students will move with a sense of urgency as they transition to their classes.

8th Grade

- 8th grade students will meet in the small gym. Doors will open at **7:45** am each morning
- 8th grade students will receive breakfast from the breakfast cart as they enter the gym.
- 8th grade students will not be permitted to take food outside of the gym.
- 8th grade students will be released to their Advocacy teacher no later than 8:25 am
- 8th grade students will transition to class using **ONLY STAIRWELL C** stairwell outside of the gym near t-buildings.
- Students will move with a sense of urgency as they transition to their classes.

Late arrivals

- Students that arrive to school after 8:40 am will report to the main office for a pass to class.
- Students that arrive late due to HISD transportation will be provided breakfast upon their arrival. <u>Individual students that are late will not receive breakfast after 8:45 am.</u> Breakfast is officially concluded at 9:00 am.

Hallway Transitions



- Students will be given 3 minutes to transition from class to class.
- Students will be allowed to go to the bathroom during transition time.
- Students are to travel on the right side of the hallway.
- Students' conversation level is at a low tone.
- Student are not allowed to run in the hallways.
- Students are not allowed to consume food in the hallway.
- Hats should not be worn indoors at any time.
- HALLWAYS/CAFÉ'/CLASSROOMS ARE "NO CELL PHONE ZONES"
- Teachers are to be at their doors greeting students as they enter, as well as ensuring students are moving through the hallways safely to class EVERY PERIOD. Active monitoring is an expectation of all teachers and staff on duty during passing period.

Cafeteria Procedures



- Students will enter the cafeteria in a line, and voice levels are at a low tone.
- Students will be seated at tables in order as they enter the café.
- Students will be called by tables to enter the serving lines
- There will be a cafeteria monitor supervising each serving line.
- Students will pick-up food tray and return to seat.
- Once seated, students must have a monitor's permission to get water or go to the restroom.
- Cafeteria monitors will monitor their sections with due diligence to ensure students are on task.
- Cafeteria monitors will be spread out, actively monitoring and not on their devices.
- <u>Students are not allowed to have cell phones out during lunch</u>. Students will be given (1) warning before the phone is confiscated with a \$15 fee attached.

- 6th grade students and teachers will exit the building using **ONLY STAIRWELL 2.**
- **6**th grade teachers will escort his/her students to the courtyard and remain on duty until all of his/her students have exited the campus by walking/boarded a bus/pick-up by car.
- TEACHERS ARE TO REMAIN ON <u>ACTIVE</u> DUTY UNTIL 4:10 PM.

7th Grade

- Wait for the announcement to begin transitioning 6th/7th/8th grade classes. Do not dismiss students before time. The teacher will be held accountable for any students from their last period classes that are unsupervised.
- 7th grade students and teachers will exit the building using **ONLY STAIRWELL 3.**
- 7th grade teachers will escort his/her students to the café and out of the rear double doors. and remain on duty until all of his/her students have exited the campus by walking/boarded a bus/pick-up by car.
- TEACHERS ARE TO REMAIN ON ACTIVE DUTY UNTIL 4:10 PM.

8th Grade

- Wait for the announcement to begin transitioning 6th/7th/8th grade classes. Do not dismiss students before time. The teacher will be held accountable for any students from their last period classes that are unsupervised.
- 8th grade students and teachers will exit the building using **ONLY STAIRWELL C** near the teacher's lounge at the end of A hall.
- 8th grade teachers will escort his/her students down the stairwell and through the T-Bldgs.
 Gate. Teachers will walk students on the sidewalk to the courtyard. Students that ride
 busses may exit the line and board their bus. NO STANDING AROUND. All others will
 continue to follow the teacher to the courtyard where car rides and walkers can be
 dismissed.
- <u>All 8th grade teachers</u> will remain on duty until all his/her students have exited the campus by walking/boarded a bus/pick-up by car.
- TEACHERS ARE TO REMAIN ON ACTIVE DUTY UNTIL 4:10 PM.
