

The application process

For Carnegie Vanguard high School

<u>Carnegie</u> <u>Vanguard</u> <u>High School</u> <u>requirements</u>

Your student MUST be identified Gifted and Talented by HISD.

You Must live within HISD catchment

We only accept 9th and 10th graders



How to apply

<u>STEP 1:</u>

Fill out an application online

(a link to the application is available on CVHS website under quick links).

- > Opens December 10, 2024
- Deadline is February 12, 2025



STEP 2: HISD GT status

If your student is already GT by HISD

- APPLY
- SUBMIT

NO DOCUMENTS ARE NEEDED.STUDENT IS ALREADY QUALIFIED.

To be identified Gifted and Talented by HISD

You need:

 The results from an achievement test and a cognitive test taken at your zoned middle school (request for testing deadline was September 16).

2. Provide your last year final report card to the middle school where your child tested.

3. the **Teacher recommendation completed** by a current core teacher.

provide the current core teacher's email to the HISD Zoned Middle School's GT coordinator.

<u>lf your</u> student is **NOT GT** by **HISD**

• <u>3 cases are possible:</u>

- 1. If your child was identified GT by HISD but you left the district, please email me the HISD GT matrix proving his/her GT status. My email is <u>Imoumni@houstonisd.org</u>.
- 2. If your child was identified by another district or State, please email me all the identification proofs that you have, and the District GT committee will evaluate your child's GT status with HISD. My email is Imoumni@houstonisd.org.
- **3.** Request GT testing at your current school. Once you receive their GT identification and GT test scores then email them to me for an evaluation by HISD district GT department.

Additional information about testing

No other tests are acceptable.

We can only accept tests if they were taken **on HISD premises** and are dated from the current school year.



Emails will be sent:

- To confirm **application submission**.
- To notify you if documentation is required.
- To send you **reminders.**

Pick an email you check often!

10 Possible Choices Parents may apply to a combination of 10 School Choice transfer or Magnet applications.

Number of Magnet Choices	Number of Possible Choice Transfers
0 Magnet Choices	10 Choice Transfers are available if a Magnet choice is not selected.
1 Magnet Choice	9 Choice Transfers available
2 Magnet Choices	8 Choice Transfers available
3 Magnet Choices	7 Choice Transfers available
4 Magnet Choices	6 Choice Transfers available
5 Magnet Choices	5 Choice Transfers available

FOR CARNEGIE VANGUARD HIGH SCHOOL

There is only one transfer possible and this is an <u>Employee school-based</u> transfer.

There are no other transfer possible.

<u>Step 6</u>: <u>Ranking!!!</u>

10 possible choices between Choice transfer and magnet choice.

How to rank them: Order of importance!

Rank #1 the school you want to go to!

Ranking information




The deadline to rank is **February 12th**!



After this date you WILL NOT be able to change your ranking!



Make sure to rank your schools according to where your child wants to go!

- Scenario1 /scenario 2

Scenario #1

- Rank 1= CVHS accepted
- Rank 2= Bellaire HS
- Rank 3= DeBakey HS
- Rank 4= Westbury HS
- Rank 5= Heights HS
- 1. You have until **April 3rd, 2025,** to let us know if you want the seat otherwise your seat will be dropped.
- 2. Provide a Proof of Residence
- 3. Sign the Entrance Agreement

Scenario #2:

- Rank 1= CVHS waitlisted and ALIVE!
- Rank 2= Bellaire HS waitlisted and ALIVE!
- Rank 3= DeBakey HS accepted
- Rank 4= Westbury HS
- Rank 5= Heights HS

You MUST accept your seat at Debakey HS;

it will not drop you from your higher ranked choice!

Ranking information

The deadline to rank is the same deadline as the application = February 23rd, 2024!

After this date you **WILL NOT** be able to change your ranking!

Make sure to rank your schools according to where your child wants to go!

Lottery/notification

Lottery notification is:

March 20th, 2025

➢ PARENT RESPONSE DEADLINE: 4/03/25

Waitlist management and movement

- The waitlist will work simultaneously with the lottery list.
- If you are called from the waitlist, you will have 5 days to let us know if you want the seat or not.
- in addition to the system's email, we will email you only once.
- After 5 days without an answer, we will move on to the next person on the waitlist.
- We moved the waitlist until <u>one week</u> <u>before school starts.</u>

Step 7: Accept or decline!

Parents have until **Thursday April 3rd 2025** to make a decision.

<u>If no answer by</u> <u>April 3rd =</u> <u>declined seat</u>

What about transportation?

HISD guarantees transportation to all magnet schools (for students accepted to that school).

Transportation has been changed to a HUB system.

Please be aware that the first weeks of school, the transportation department often adjusts and changes the routes.



<u>To</u> <u>summarize:</u>



Step 1: Apply online and submit before February 12th, 2025

Step 2: Confirm GT status



Step 3: Ranking before February 12th, 2025



Step 4: Lottery notification March 20th, 2025



<u>Step 5</u>: After notification accept or decline before April 3rd and provide necessary documents.
