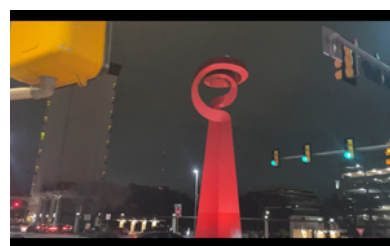
GETTING READY FOR SAN ANTONIO

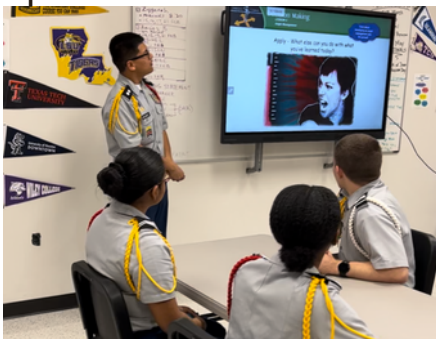

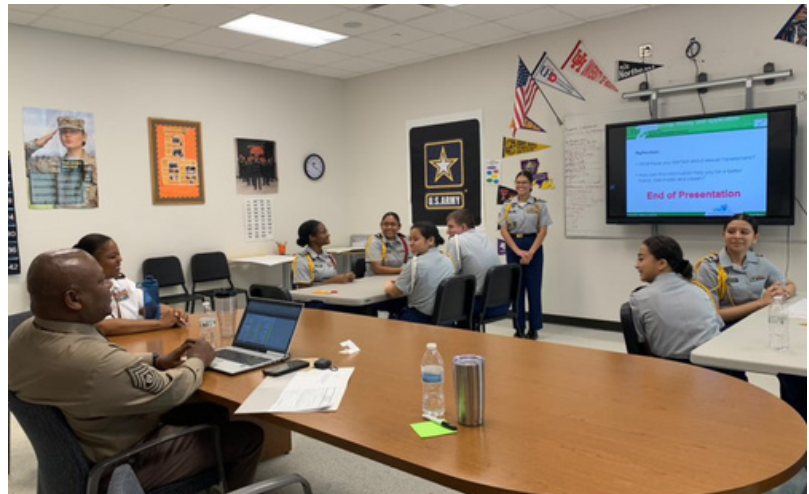
