



Accessing Curriculum via the PowerUp:HUB

What is the HUB?

The PowerUp:HUB, or HUB for short, is a K-12 digital teaching and learning platform that when fully implemented will become the hub of collaboration, curriculum, instruction, and communication for HISD staff, students, and parents.

Starting in the 2014-2015 school year, ALL teachers in ALL grades can access the district's curriculum through the HUB at www.houstonisd.org/hub.

There are two steps to accessing curriculum via the HUB:

Step 1. Log on to www.houstonisd.org/hub

To make things more efficient, access to the HUB is single sign-on, meaning once you sign-on to your computer with your HISD user id and password, you will not need to re-enter it to access the HUB.

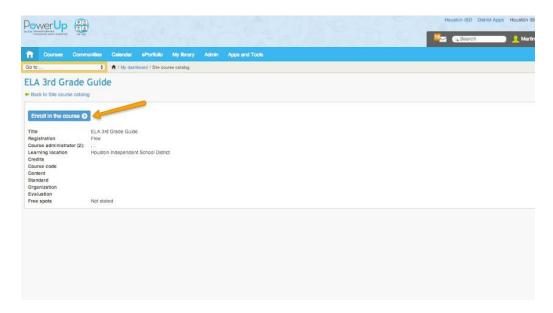
Step 2. Access Curriculum

Click on "Site Course Catalog" under "Courses" on your HUB landing page to navigate to the particular course(s) you are trying to view. From there you will be taken to a Site Course Catalog page where you will look or search for the particular courses whose curricula you seek. Generally, courses are named <Subject> then <Level> then "Guide," such as "ELA 7th Grade Guide." From there, you enroll in the course as shown below.









Accessing Curriculum through eLearn

Please plan to use the HUB as the *primary source* for HISD curriculum access. If you encounter any difficulties, core curricula will be loaded into www.hisdelearn.org for the 2014-2015 school year as a backup measure. Use self-registration to access curriculum on eLearn if necessary. Full instructions are available at eLearn under the Elementary and Secondary Curriculum icons. Curriculum on eLearn is organized by content area.
