1. Go to houstonlibrary.org or download the Libby or HPL app. You may be asked to enter HOUSTON PUBLIC LIBRARY.
2. Sign-in: First letter of LAST name + ID number
Ex. B1234567
3. Password: Birthday Month/Day Ex. 0819 - no year
