2019-2020 Casual Dress Guideline

Items	Requirements
Student ID	Required for all students: All students are required to wear their school issued ID daily. (must be visible)
Shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • JY Logo Monday – Thursday, always. • JY Organization, JY Spirit, JY Class shirt or JY Logo collar shirt on <i>Fridays</i> only. • All uniform shirts must be unaltered and appropriately sized (<i>not form fitting or tight</i>). • All shirts must have sleeves. No <u>sleeveless shirts</u>. • No shirts or tops that will show your stomach, i.e. <u>NO</u> midriff tops.
Bottoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black or tan khakis pants, or black or khaki knee length shorts Monday-Thursday. • Solid jeans are allowed on <u>Fridays ONLY</u> (no rips, tears, frays, holes, even if skin is NOT showing) • <u>NO</u> leggings, tights, jeggings, joggers, pajamas or sleepwear, jogging pants/sweats, athletic pants; <u>NO</u> bike, athletic, mesh, dry-fit or sweat material shorts. <u>NO</u> spandex, and <u>NO</u> skirts. • <u>NO</u> undergarments should be exposed. • Pants must always be worn at <u>appropriate waist-line</u>.
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students <u>shall</u> wear appropriate footwear while on school grounds, participating in school activities, or on school transportation. • All shoes must be <u>close-toed with a backing</u> that covers the heel (Toes and heels must not be visible). • <u>NO</u> house shoes, <u>NO</u> shower shoes, <u>NO</u> flip flops, <u>NO</u> slides, <u>NO</u> mesh slides, <u>NO</u> furry slides, <u>NO</u> Ugg slides, <u>NO</u> see-thru slippers, <u>NO</u> sandals, <u>No</u> Crocs, <u>NO</u> oversized furry animal house shoes, <u>NO</u> stilettos.
Other Garments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No swim or bathing wear or dresses. • Jewelry and other accessories shall not convey prohibited messages such as gang or drug related symbols, or messages. • Dog collars, wallet chains, chains that connect one body part to another, large metal hair picks, or other jewelry/accessories that pose a safety concern for the student or others are prohibited. • Jewelry of any kind may be prohibited, as pertained to class safety standards. i.e. science classes or project-based learning. • Sunglasses <u>shall not</u> be worn to class or within the school building unless prescribed by a physician.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sweatshirts/jackets must be worn with a JY logo collar shirt underneath on Monday – Thursdays or JY Organization, JY Spirit, JY Class shirt or JY Logo collar shirt on <u>Fridays</u> only. No blankets, pillows, or stuffed animals. <u>NO</u> caps, hats, scarves, curlers, sweatbands, hair bonnets, shower caps, scarves, wraps, durags, and bandanas even on a “bad hair” day.
Gang or Drug Paraphernalia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Are <u>NOT</u> allowed in the building or classroom under any circumstances. <u>NO</u> clothing with Gang or Drug Paraphernalia is allowed in the building or classroom.
Religious and Health Accommodations	When a bona fide religious belief or health need of a student conflicts with the school dress code, reasonable accommodation shall be made. Any student desiring accommodations shall notify the school principal in writing of the requested accommodation and factual basis for the request. Approved coverings worn as part of a student’s religious practices shall not be prohibited under this policy.
Note	Yates administrators reserve the right to determine if a student dress is out of dress code or in any way inappropriate. Administrative decisions will be final. If it is determined by an administrator that a student is dressed inappropriately, the student may not attend classes until dressed appropriately. Chronic violation of the Dress Code Policy may result in further disciplinary actions as described in the HISD Code of Student Conduct.
