District Goals:

The percentage of students reading and writing at or above grade level for grade 3 through English II will increase by 3 percentage points annually between spring 2017 and spring 2020.

Among students who exhibit below satisfactory performance on state assessments, the percentage who demonstrate at least one year of academic growth will increase 3 percentage points annually in reading and in math between spring 2017 and spring 2020.

School Goals:

Increase percentage passing 2019 Reading STAAR from 50% to 70% (3rd Grade), 43% to 75% (4th Grade), 54% to 75% (5th Grade).

Increase percentage passing on the 2019 Math STAAR from 60% to 75% (3rd Grade), 54% to 70% (4th Grade), and 61% to 75% (5th Grade).

Increase school attendance from 96.4% to 98% by the end of the year.

At School:

Ashford Elementary School will:

1. Provide high quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment.
2. Hold parent-teacher conferences and provide frequent reports to keep parents informed of their child's individual achievements.

3. Provide parents with reasonable access to staff.

4. Provide parents with opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class and observe classroom activities. (Please contact your child's teacher and PTO to find out how you can help.)
