# District Health and Safety Protocols

- Physical distancing will be practiced in the classroom, hallways, common areas, and throughout the building inside and out.
- Daily deep cleaning will occur throughout the campus with an emphasis on high touch surfaces.
- Temperature checks will be conducted daily for everyone on campus (faculty, staff, and students).

# District Health and Safety Protocols

- If COVID-19 cases are identified, campuses will be closed/sanitized.
  - Notifications will be provided to impacted parents and students if possibly exposed. |
- Students, staff, and anyone on campus will be required to wear masks at all times, which will be provided daily.

# District Health and Safety Protocols

- If my child or staff member on campus tests positive for COVID-19, will the building be shut down?
  - If COVID-19 cases are identified, campuses will be closed/sanitized. Notifications will be provided to impacted parents and students who have possibly been exposed. Instruction will shift to virtual learning if the school closes.

# Parent Survey and Selection Process

- September 21-25: Timeline parents were asked to make a selection of face to face or continued virtual through the HISD Connect Parent Portal
- Per HISD, once a selection is submitted, the selection is **final** for the current six-week period and cannot be updated until the selection window is opened again.
- Students for which a selection has not been made by the deadline automatically will be selected for in-person learning for planning purposes.
- The number of students participating in face-to-face instruction will determine the type of schedule a campus will follow, such as a hybrid or rotating schedule.

# What will MLCPA look like if parents select face-to-face instruction?

- Current certified MLCPA teachers will provide instruction in the classroom.
- Teachers will be delivering instruction on campus and virtually simultaneously through HISD laptops and Microsoft Teams.
- Physical distancing will be enforced with reduced class sizes.
- Physical distancing signage placed around the campus.
- Schools will distribute disposable masks daily (one per staff member and one per student).
- Grading and attendance policies remain the same as first 6 weeks.

# What will MLCPA look like if parents select face-to-face instruction? Continued...

- Disinfectant wipes will be provided for classrooms and campus.
- Gloves will be provided for classrooms and campus.
- Health screening app will be used by employees for check-in.
- Masks are always required to be worn properly by students and staff.
- Social activities and campus movement be limited.
- Students will take laptops and materials home every day in case the campus suddenly reverts to 100% virtual instruction.
- HISD is making decision on attendance if a student is absent from campus but participates in a class virtually.

# What will MLCPA look like if parents select virtual instruction?

- Current certified MLCPA teachers will provide instruction virtually.
- Teachers will be delivering instruction on campus and virtually simultaneously via Microsoft Teams.
- Grading and attendance policies remain the same as first 6 weeks.

# HISD Bus Transportation

- HISD bus transportation is provided to special education, homeless, and priority students.
- Once HISD has preliminary numbers the determination of transportation for all students, including magnet schools, will be made.
- If transportation is provided, buses will arrive as usual with students entering main entrance.
- If transportation is provided, students will dismiss by bus number exiting through main entrance.
- PPE, and wellness screening stations will be at main front doors.

# Arrival/Dismissal

- Student drop off and pick up will take place at the Gregg Street at main entrance.
- PPE distribution and wellness screening stations will be at main office front doors
- Isolation areas on first floor in the main be available as needed.

# Campus Logistics

- The building will open at 7:30 am and close at 4:00 pm.
- HISD will continue to provide free breakfast and lunch to students.
- Students may get breakfast and/or lunch from the cafeteria line and alternate locations.(middle and high school commons, court yards and learning stairs
- Students may bring their lunch but may not share with others.
- HISD is changing HVAC system filters on a regular basis.
- If a student feels uncomfortable at anytime, they should tell an adult.

# Campus Logistics

- One way traffic in hallways, student required to social distancing.
- Restrooms will not be available during passing periods.
- Teachers will allow students to have restroom breaks one student at a time.
- Water fountains will only be available to fill reusable/labeled water bottles.
- Isolation areas on first floor and fourth floor will be available as needed.
