

Worthing High School Policy for IB Admissions

for Career Program

Worthing High School students who want to challenge themselves academically and engage in learning that will deeply enhance their knowledge will be afforded the opportunity to achieve this accomplishment. We will encourage our students to select the academic pathway that will be appropriate for the academic level in which they want to pursue.

Students applying for the Worthing High School IBCP should:

- Be willing to challenge themselves everyday
- Be curious and want to problem solve
- Be able to engage in independent research
- Follow a high moral and ethical code in their personal and academic life

Students who choose to participate in the IBCP will not be required to take an entrance exam. There will be no minimum standardized test score, grade point average, or subject level grade that must be achieved. Students who express interest in their 10th grade year will meet with the IB Coordinator and their counselor to discuss the CP option and create a plan forward to accomplish the CP certificate. Teachers and Administrators can nominate students for entry into the IBCP programme and the students will meet with the IB Coordinator and their Counselor to discuss the IBCP programme and create a plan within the IBCP to accomplish the CP certificate.

Students who wish to take just the IB courses offered at Worthing High School will have the same opportunity and will meet with the IB coordinator and their counselor to either take 1 or 2 of the IB courses on offer at Worthing High School.

Our policy will be reviewed annually by the Worthing High School IB Team who includes Head of School, IB Coordinator, IB Lead Teacher Cohort School Year.
