#### DIRECTOR'S NOTE ...

The Wiz is one of my favorite musicals: spectacular, Black, highly-energetic, and cleverly inventive - everything I love to see on the high school musical theatre stage! The Wiz is a celebration of our legendary presence in the music industry, and a love letter to our limitless future in this country with Black music and liberation as the gleaming engine driving it all full speed ahead!

The Wiz was created to show that wHolesome characters and stories can belong to Black actors. The Wiz does not present Black people suffering or as downtrodden servants, but rather, it is a celebration of the love and strength at the heart of the African-American family and the limitless virtuosity in Black music, dance, and visual arts that has been emulated around the world since the invention of jazz.

In Dorothy, the Scarecrow, Tinman, and the Lion we see the resilience of the Black American dream despite nearly unbeatable odds in a rigged and corrupted system that doles out false promises behind a slick mask of unreachable materialism. In our production the Emerald City is a bustling metropolis rife with moral temptations, and the Winkies, the working poor pressed under the boot of the exploitative tyrant, Evilline.

The Wiz is a lifelong favorite of mine and I leapt at the opportunity to express my love for this unique Afro-futurism sci-fi musical. I let myself be inspired by Black artists and things that were a part of my childhood and current artists that influence me and connect with the young people of HSPVA.

In a world where faith and hope can sometimes be in short supply I wanted to create the feeling that anything is possible and that magic can happen right here where we are! I want to warmly welcome you to our show and it is without shame or irony that I encourage you to believe in the Black magic that is HSPVA's All School Black History Production of *The Wiz*!

# **HISTORY OF THE WIZ**

*The Wiz* is an Afrofuturistic retelling of the Frank L. Baum classic, "The Wonderful Wizard of Oz." This show celebrates Black music and culture, and it represents many timeless aspects of our society and the people in it.

*The Wiz* first opened in Baltimore in 1974 and was met with many mixed reviews as it made its way to New York. Despite the overall uncertainty toward the show's future, *The Wiz* made its way to Broadway in early 1975. The show continued to be met with poor reviews by New York critics, and it was unclear how much the show would be able to take before it would have to close.

However, an editorial from the Amsterdam News - the oldest Black newspaper in the country - was published, urging Black theatergoers to see the production and emphasized the popularization of the show would rely heavily on the people spreading the word. That editorial, as well as a successful publicity campaign that featured the cast singing a rendition of "Ease On Down the Road," played a major role in the success of the show.

Later that year, *The Wiz* won seven Tony awards, including one for best musical. A few years after the musical became a hit, a movie adaptation of *The Wiz* was written and eventually released to public theaters late 1978. Despite the issues that the movie faced in pre and post-production, as well as the initially damaging reviews it faced when released to the public, it still became the blockbuster classic we know it as today.
