PROGRAMS

At HSLJ, students take vocational classes beginning their freshmen year to provide them with the proper skills and experience necessary for law enforcement and legal-related criminal justice careers. Read about our top programs below.



LEGAL STUDIES

The courses offered give students a solid foundation in the legal system, and perspectives towards careers in political science. Students are able to interact in court procedures getting first hand experience in legal studies.



FIRE TECHNOLOGY: DUAL CREDIT

Starting junior year students are eligible to take part in this program taught by college professors. The Fire Tech program gives students hands on experience alongside firefighters, exposing them to the career itself.



JROTC HIGHLIGHTS

The HSLJ JROTC program is designed to teach high school students the value of citizenship, leadership, service to the community, personal responsibility, and a sense of accomplishment, while instilling in them self-esteem, teamwork, and self discipline.



CRIMINAL JUSTICE
