Reading Curriculum

Math Curriculum

- Students master math concepts through hands-on learning that emphasizes real-world connections and use of multiple problem-solving strategies.
- Teacher will pull them in small groups to differentiate the learning.
- Students solve problems moving from concrete to pictorial to abstract.


