



By June 2023, the average daily attendance (ADA) for Field Elementary will be 96.3% or higher compared to 95.3% during the 2022-2023 school year.

By June 2025, the average daily attendance (ADA) for Field Elementary will be 96.5% or higher.

Compared to 6% during the 2023-2024 school year, the percent of students considered as chronically absent during the 2024-2025 school year will decrease to 5% by the end of Cycle 3 and then 4% by the end of Cycle 6.

Attendance & Tardies

ATTENDANCE

- Attendance is taken at 9:30AM every day
- All student absences must be documented with an excuse note and submitted to Ms. Martinez.
- Students with multiple absences will not be allowed to participate in school activities such as field trips and class reward days.
- On the 19th absence (excused or unexcused), the student automatically fails for the year and must attend summer school.
- Campus has created an Attendance Committee and Attendance Action
 Plan

Attendance & Tardies

TARDIES

- Students are considered tardy after 7:35AM
- Any more than six (6) tardies during a six-week grading cycle is regarded as excessive and will result in lowering the conduct grade on the report card which may result in the loss of a field trip, special events and/or extra-curricular activities.
- Arrival begins at 7:00AM--come early!

School Uniforms

- Students must wear uniform daily (unless specified by Principal)
- Items not allowed:
 - Hoods
 - Rolling backpacks
 - Ripped or torn jeans
 - Open toed shoes, slippers,
 crocs
 - Pajamas

Breakfast and Lunch

Breakfast

- Free breakfast is available to every student, every day.
- Breakfast is served in the classroom and ends at 7:45AM
- Students cannot bring coffee or energy drinks to school.
- If possible, students are encouraged to eat breakfast at home before arrival.
- Students are engaged with instruction during breakfast.

<u>Lunch</u>

- Free lunch is available to every student, every day.
- Students are allowed to bring a sack lunch from home (not fast food)
- Forgotten lunch can be dropped off at the front office by 10AM (not fast food)
- Students can purchase ice cream/treats in the cafeteria at an additional cost

Parent Lunch Week

- Parents are invited to eat lunch with their child during 'Parent Week'
- Dates and details will be communicated via Class Dojo, PTO, and social media
- Increased from 3 days to 4 days per month

- o The earlier the better!


Arrival Location (K-5)

Dismissal Procedures

Bring your car rider tag every day!


- PK students will be dismissed on Beverly Street at the playground area.
- PALS, SLL or Bus Riders will be dismissed on Beverly Street in the Bus Zone.
- Kindergarten 2nd grade students will be dismissed in the front of the school on 17th Street.
- 3rd 5th grade students will be dismissed in the back of the school on 18th Street.

Dismissal Procedures

- For student safety, students will not be allowed to get in a car or go with a walker pick-up if there is not a dismissal tag.
- Car or walker pickups without a dismissal card must go to the office to verify pick-up approval and sign the student out.
- All walkers must line-up outside the gate and wait for a staff member to release your child to you--families are not allowed to pick-up their child if they are not in line
