- Teachers will develop interventions (small group and individual) for students who do not demonstrate mastery during the lesson cycle.


- Senior passing rates

- School Leaders will host: Save a Senior Credit Recovery in December and April.

- Homeroom teachers will monitor seniors monthly.
- Assistant Principals will meet twice a month to review senior EAPs with the teachers.
- Content teachers will provide support for the Save a Senior Credit Recovery.
