#### **Dress Code and Electronic Device Policies:**

- **Dress Code:** All students should return to full uniform starting tomorrow to avoid campus consequences.
- **Electronic Devices:** Students are not permitted to have electronic devices visible at any time from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM. Devices must be stored in lockers or backpacks during school hours. If a device is confiscated, a \$15 fee will be required for its return, and parents will need to pick it up from the office.
- House Shoes: House shoes are not allowed on campus at any time.
- **Hooded Jackets:** Students are not allowed to wear hooded jackets during the school day, from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM. Jackets must be stored in lockers or backpacks during school hours.
- Backpacks: All backpacks should be clear or mesh.
- Student IDs: IDs should be worn around necks at all times.

#### **Behavior Expectations:**

- Hallway Conduct: Students should not run in the hallways and are expected to walk calmly between classes.
- Noise Levels: Yelling or screaming is not permitted. We encourage a respectful and quiet atmosphere throughout the school day.

If any items that violate these expectations are confiscated, parents will need to retrieve them from the office. We ask that you please speak with your child to help reinforce the importance of following campus rules.

We're proud of our students' efforts so far and excited to see them achieve their goals as the semester concludes.

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### **Exciting Updates!**




