T-Tess 1.3: Knowledge of Students

- All lessons connect to students' prior knowledge and experiences.
- Adjusts the lesson to address strengths and learning gaps of all students.

Strategy to Implement Regin with end in mind

Begin With the End is a strategy in which the teacher identifies standards for a unit, breaks them down into smaller objectives, develops an assessment plan, and then creates lessons with aligned activities.

It generates higher quality lessons because teachers are focused on the intended outcome throughout the planning process.

With so much content to cover in a single class or subject area, it is easy to unintentionally craft lessons that are not in line with the ultimate goal.

By working backwards, or beginning with the end, teachers can plan each step (the unit goals, the assessments, the lessons, and the activities) so they stay focused on the finish line.
