





**Supporting Documentation for Enrollment** 

All new incoming families must bring the following supporting documentation for enrollment:

## **Proof of Residence**: Types of proof of residence accepted:

- o **If you are living in your own home:** provide electric bill, gas bill or water bill which shows both the service address and the billing address. **Must be within the past 30 days to current date, counting the day you** are registering your child.
- o **If you are living in an apartment or leasing a house:** provide a current, valid lease naming the parent or court-appointed guardian. The lease must be signed by the lease-holder, the landlord/apartment manager, and contain a phone number where we may contact the landlord. **The lease must be active for the 2019-2020 School Year. (All lease agreements must be accompanied with an electric bill.) Please bring the entire typed leased agreement.**
- If you are living with more than one family in a house or apartment due to economic hardship:
  - Houston ISD Statement of Residence Affidavit
  - Home owner current utility bill: electric bill, gas bill, or water bill
  - Current lease agreement for the person with whom you reside.

(All lease agreements must be accompanied with an electric bill.) Please bring the entire typed leased agreement.

Home owner/lease holder valid Driver's License

<u>Parent Identification:</u> Valid Driver's License, State ID, or Military ID or <u>Passport</u> (Non-US Residents only)

## **Report Card:**

- Summer registration, please provide the final report card for the 2018-2019 school year.
- If registering <u>from another country</u>, please provide any school records (translated), including grading scale.
