What is the purpose of the program?

The program will...

- introduce students to the Digital Media & Design career pathway offered by WHS
- introduce students to Project-Based Learning and Linked Learning.
- ensure students' familiarity with the high school campus.
- build leadership and collaboration.
- enhance student confidence, self-esteem, and motivation.
- ease the transition from middle school to high school.

All sessions focus on high interest topics and activities, so that the day feels more like a summer camp than school. In addition to attending sessions, students will participate in a field trip during the last week.

All incoming 9th grade students who are interested in spending 2 weeks packed full of fun educational experiences are encouraged to register at NO cost.
