March 28th Share Decision Making Committee Meeting Notes

The meeting started at 4:20 pm with Principal Williams greeting everyone present. The following topics were discussed:

- Budget: The Principal will work with the executive director of support and budget analyst on the next steps in the Lanier MS 2024-25 budget process. Principal Williams has invited River Oaks principal to join in the meeting as another layer of continued feeder support. ELA curriculum will remain the same, but Carnegie will not. Math will transition to STEM Scope, which has supplemental support embedded. Geometry will use Pearson SAAVAS.
- Wraparound: It was emphasized that Wraparound is a valuable resource. The principal will advocate for including Ms. Valle (Wraparound services) in the budget until a district decision is made.
- Solar Eclipse: On April 8, 2024, at 1:20 pm, there will be a Solar Eclipse, and students, teachers, and volunteers will be participating. Students who will not participate will be placed in the auditorium.
- Social Emotional: Mr. Williams led a discussion about plans to secure an SEL curriculum to support ongoing campus needs. He shared that his long-term goal is to create alignment with Lanier and other feeder schools. Campus is looking into Community partnerships will work with PUP and teachers to promote more kindness and anti-bullying, as well as IB principals on campus.
- Course Selection: Students will be using a new platform called School Links via Canvas to select their 2024-2025 courses. The deadline for course selection is April 5th.
