





Welcome to the 2024-2025 school year! As we move into the new destination for preparing students for 2035 global competitiveness, we are sending an updated dress code for all students. The dress code will be strictly enforced at MC Williams.

Shirts:



- Shirts must be plain / free of logos, writing, rips, etc.
- Shirts must not be transparent (see through)
- Shirts must fit appropriately. Form-fitting or oversized shirts are prohibited. Shirts must not show belly button or other body parts.
- Shirts may not be cut or altered in any way (including writing, graffiti, rips, tears, worn inside-out, or worn backward)
- All undershirts must be white.
- Undershirts must fit properly (not oversized or visible below the waist of the uniform shirt)

Bottoms:

- Blue, black, khaki Pants, or Capri pants, must be khaki in color and always worn at the waist. A belt may be needed to comply with this policy. If a belt is worn, it must be brown or black. Gym shorts will not be allowed to be worn over school slacks/pants.
- Short must be knee length.
- Blue Jeans without rips or tears
- Pants should be cuffed or straight hemmed. Slack/pant legs are not to be tied, folded or rolled up at the ankles.
- Lycra, spandex, leggings, tights, etc. are prohibited.
- Pants or Capris may not have any adornments or logos.
- Sagging or baggy pants, jumpers, overalls, and midriff blouses are not permitted.
- Pants may not be frayed or split and cannot drag on the floor.







Shoes:

• **Not allowed** - Open-toed shoes, house shoes, slippers, flip-flops, Crocs, sandals or any shoe without a hard sole or back are not allowed.



Jackets:

- Jackets must be a solid MCW color (navy blue, white or grey).
- Hoodies are not allowed to be worn in the building while on campus.
- Coats may be worn to school on cold days but must be removed inside the building.

Identification Badges:

- All students must always wear ID Badges on a lanyard around their neck. No exceptions.
- Students without an ID Badge will need to purchase a temporary badge for \$1.

Hair/Head Coverings:

- No hats, caps, bandanas, scarves, earmuffs, hair wraps, bonnets, combs, picks may be worn on campus.
- Headbands may be worn in the building if their purpose is to hold the hair in place and they do not distract from instruction.
- Head coverings worn for religious purposes or medical purposes are permitted.
