GT Testing

HISD's Gifted and Talented Programs serve students who have been identified by HISD as gifted and talented in general intellectual ability.

HISD screens kindergarten and fifth grade students who were not previously identified as gifted and talented in what is called Universal Testing. This process begins the week of October 21, 2019. An Abilities Test and an Achievement Test are administered universally to all kindergarten and fifth grade students for Gifted and Talented (G/T) identification. The Abilities Test and the Achievement Test has been scheduled for October 21 - December 14, 2019. Upon completion of the G/T identification process, parents are notified and will receive a copy of the completed G/T Identification Matrix.

If your child qualifies, the Gifted and Talented Coordinator will contact you and your child will receive G/T services the following school year. Students in grade first through fourth grade may test during the appropriate window by submitting a GT application. These can be found on the GT website or at the school's front office.

- <u>G/T Testing Window</u> (Current 1st grade 4th grade) This window is for children in 1st-4th grade who choose to apply for testing. Applications for the G/T Testing Window are available at the front office. Completed applications are due by **Friday**, **December 6**, and should only be submitted to the front office. <u>Please do not turn in applications to your child's teacher</u>. If you choose to apply, give the blank Teacher Recommendation Form to your child's homeroom teacher. Any necessary testing will be scheduled during the testing window of October 21 December 14. Testing will take place on campus, during the school day. Although the deadline is Dec. 6th, please turn in your application as soon as possible so testing can begin **next week.**
- <u>Universal Testing Window</u> (Current kindergarten and 5th grade) All kindergarten and 5th grade students not previously identified as G/T will be tested during HISD's Universal Testing Window, October 28 December 3. There is no application for this testing window. Testing will take place on campus, during the school day.
