

Frequently Asked Questions for National Honor Society #FAQs4NHS

What are the requirements to be in NHS?

Students in grades 11 and 12 who meet the requirements for membership are invited for membership towards the end of the school year. The qualifications for membership, are based on the four pillars of NHS: **Scholarship**: Per national guidelines, at a minimum, students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, **Service**: This involves voluntary contributions made by a student to the school or community, done without compensation. **Leadership**: Student leaders are those who are resourceful, good problem solvers, and idea contributors. Leadership experiences can be drawn from school or community activities while working with or for others. **Character**: The student of good character is cooperative; demonstrates high standards of honesty and reliability; shows courtesy, concern, and respect for others; and maintains a clean disciplinary record.

How much are NHS Membership Dues?

Waltrip NHS membership dues are \$20 a year per member. The dues can be paid directly to Ms. Andrews, or to Ms. Campos in Waltrip's Finance Office.


Who are the NHS Executive Officers?
