Lame That Book this year? Here's how

Are you interested in joining Name That Book this year? Here's how to join the club and make the 2019 competition team!

What is Name That Book?

Name That Book is an HISD competition sponsored by the Department of Library Services. Students in grades K-2 read a list of 30 books, studying the words and pictures. At the district competition in February, students are given clues or quotes and asked to name that book. The six team members must choose the correct book cover in 45 seconds.

T.H. Rogers has very competitive Name That Book teams. In 2018, the K-2 team won 1st place at their competition and didn't miss a single question. The 3-5 team won 2nd and the Middle School team won 1st place at their respective HISD finals!

So, if you love to read, have a good memory for detail, and can dedicate the time to reading and rereading the books on the list, you should try out for Name That Book!

Joining the Name That Book Club:

- 1. In order to join the Name That Book Club this fall, students will have to qualify by scoring well on a test during recess on September 25, 2018. The test will cover 15 of the titles, and these titles are in **bold** on the complete list on the back of this sheet. The top 20 scoring students will be a part of the club. (A minimum score of 4 out of 15 is also required.)
- 2. Students in the club will be required to attend every meeting. K-2 NTB Club will meet after school on <u>Wednesdays</u> from 3:15 to 4:00 pm. If a student misses more than 2 meetings, they will be dismissed from the club for the year. Parents must be able to pick up students promptly at 4:00 pm or enroll their child in after-school care which allows them to be picked up by 6:00 pm.
- 3. Behavior infractions will also result in dismissal from the club. Students will be given only one written behavior warning!
- 4. Club members are required to take notes on the books they read. K-2 students will be required to write quotes from the books to be used in practices. They must bring a typed list of at least 10 quotes, plus one physical clue, and one audio clue from a different book each week. (Parents can help!) Club members who do not bring their quotes on time for two weeks will be subject to dismissal from the club.
- 5. A test will be given to all club members on December 5, 2018. This test will cover all of the books on the list. The top 7 scoring students will become our competition team. Each competition team is comprised of six members and one alternate. The team member who will serve as alternate will be decided by a final test closer to competition time. Only team members will continue to meet and practice after December.
