A Message from Our Principal

Wolf Spirit Prevails Over Hurricane Harvey

Dear Westside Students and Families,

On behalf of our faculty and staff at Westside, we are eager to wrap our collective arms around our students as they return to Westside on September 11th. The spirit of West Houston has been nothing short of inspirational and the unity and steadfastness of our community is now known by our entire nation. Westside opened its doors as a temporary shelter on 8/28 to upwards of 400 evacuees and received an outpouring of clothing, bedding, food, and supplies; all of which came from individual community members and neighbors. One evacuee, an elderly cancer patient with an open wound, was cared for in our nurse's office by a Class of 2002 volunteer who had just graduated from medical school. I'm certain each of you were helping others, or in some way doing your best to preserve the lives and safety of your loved ones. As you send your child to Westside this week, please know that a core tenet of our campus culture is knowing students personally and providing each student with individual support and guidance. Our goal is to learn the degree of impact each of our families experienced, and to leverage all resources to respond appropriately; needs

ranging from complete loss of home and belongings to feelings of survivor's guilt. Students will be provided an opportunity to describe how they were impacted and need for assistance, or volunteer to help others. This information will be held confidential between the student and their assigned dean and/or social worker. We also encourage our parents/guardians to request help directly from your child's dean, social worker, or school nurse. It is essential that every family know the name and contact information for their child's HOUSE, HOUSE SECRETARY and DEAN. This is your child's "home base" for virtually all needs! If you don't know your child's dean, the main office can assist you!

-Uniforms are still required. If you have them, you must wear them. If you lost your uniforms in the storm and cannot afford to purchase new ones, we will have assistance for you here at school. If you do not have a uniform to wear on Monday, please wear something as similar as you have, such as a WHS spirit shirt. When you get to school, we will assist you in getting them. Donated uniforms will be cleaned and processed and made available to students in need. Everyone in need will be given ample time and assistance to get uniforms.

-All students are eligible for free meals at Westside.

-If you have lost laptops or books in the storm, please bring the damaged ones to school, if you have them, and they will be exchanged. If you do not have them, parents will be asked to sign a statement that they were destroyed in the storm and they will be replaced.

We are happy to have our Wolf Family back together again!
