# **District Faces Budget Challenges**

HISD has recently announced that it will need to cut approximately \$200 Million from next year's budget. School Superintendent Richard Carranza stated, "School next year will look different."

HISD has cited a variety of issues which have resulted in this dire situation, including:

- State mandated "recapture" payment is due to be paid; Houston must "share our wealth" from property tax proceeds
- Lower student enrollment due to devastation of homes and schools by Hurricane Harvey
- Projected loss in tax revenue due to property damage by Hurricane Harvey

The district is in the early stages of planning for the impact of the shortfall. Proposals which are being considered include:

- Significant changes to the HISD Magnet Program and School Choice systems.
- Centralized school funding, as opposed to individ-

- ual principals controlling school budgets.
- Standardized staffing formulas based on student:staff ratios

Rene Barajas, the district's chief financial officer, said, "It's a sea of change for HISD, but at end of the day, from a budgetary perspective, we're still going to get the job done. It's just going to be harder."

Westside parents are encouraged to get informed and stay up to speed on the details as the district faces this major budgeting challenge. 

## **Author Event**




