# Hey, Westside students! Want to travel to China this summer?



2018 "汉语桥—美国高中生夏令营" 2018 Chinese Bridge Summer Camp

Since 2007, the Chinese Bridge Summer Camp for secondary school students is an annual Chinese language and culture experiencing activity sponsored by the Chinese Language Council International (Hanban) with the cooperation of the Confucius Institutes. This summer, the program provides two weeks of Chinese language and cultural immersion experience in multiple cities in China.



### Dates: June 15-30

### **Student Requirements**

- Must be U.S. citizens
- Students between the ages of 14-18 attending any accredited high school, including homeschool programs, in good standing with their institution may apply. Graduating seniors are welcome to participate as well.
- Although Chinese language skills are helpful, they are not required.
- A valid U.S. passport. If you already have a passport, it MUST be valid past January 1, 2019. If you need to
  obtain a passport, you must plan to have it in hand by Mar.23 2018.
- Participants must be healthy enough for international travel and to participate in the program.
- Students must be interested in Chinese language and/or culture.

#### Costs

- The in-country costs for the program are covered by the Confucius Institute Headquarter, including in-country travel, most meals, lodging, activity cost, and entrance fees for tour spots.
- Students must pay for international airfare (approx. \$2200), medical insurance (approx. \$50), Chinese travel visa (\$140), and the cost to apply for a passport if the student does not already have a valid passport.
