WEGA Students Compete at Shell STEM Showdown

A group of Westside engineering students recently competed at the 4th Annual Shell STEM Showdown, a competition for high school freshmen at the University of Houston main campus. The event is sponsored by two industry partners, the Independent Petroleum Association of America (IPAA), and the Petroleum Equipment & Services Association (PESA). Five area high schools each sent 24 students to compete in teams of eight for prizes and cash awards for their schools. Each team had a college mentor who coached them through their design challenges.

In the morning, students designed a mechanical hand using cardboard, straws, ribbon, and glue, and then used the hand to pick up and stack foam cups in a specific pattern. In the afternoon, students designed rockets from paper and cardboard tubes, which were launched using compressed air. One Westside team won the

Spirit Award for the event.

While the students worked, parents and teachers attended a separate session where they learned about Shell resources to help the students increase their interest in STEM careers.
